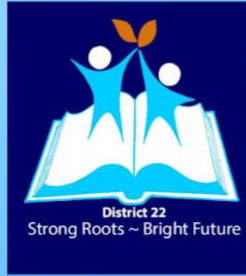

New York City Schools Account (NYCSA): It is extremely important that families sign up for a NYCSA Account. Our new DOE Messaging System offers multiple methods for outreach to families, such as voice calls, emails, and SMS texts. Our school staff will be able to send families messages by course/class, by grade, or even to the entire school. Messages can be sent in English and the nine DOE languages. You can also sign media release forms, update emergency contact information, check attendance, grades, busing, and so much more. Please contact your [parent coordinator](#) today for a creation code. 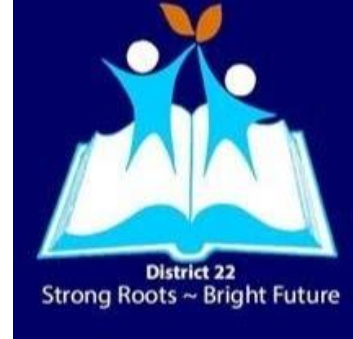
